Developing a community support model – workshops

As part of decisions made in 2017 about housing support services, Norfolk County Council has committed to reinvesting approximately £1.3-1.5m in outcome-based preventative interventions for older people and those at risk of homelessness.

We are currently gathering ideas for how this funding could impact positively on reducing demand for formal social care or for other public services, and we would like to invite you to a workshop where there will be opportunity for you to input into this process.
